

Monthly Focus: SALVATION OF THE POKOT PEOPLE

Week 1- September 1-7:

Pray for deliverance from the yoke of tradition and the worship of ancestral spirits. The Pokots are mostly animists. KISONET: Tradition of ancestral worship. They use leaves to appease the spirits of the dead.

II Cor. 10:5 Casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ

Week 2- September 8-15:

Pray that the tribal wars, motivated by stealing animals, between the Pokots and their neighbors (The Samburus, Turkanas, Ichamus, etc) would cease permanently.

Psalm 46:9- He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear in two; He burns the chariot in the fire.

Week 3- September 16-23:

Pray that God would give deliverance from drought and hunger that have regularly plagued the region. Thousands of people are totally dependent on food help from outside.

Leviticus 26:4- "Then I will give you rain in its season, the land shall yield its produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit."

Week 4- September 24-30:

That the Lord would call (from every part of the world), prepare and send more harvesters to the mission field.

Luke 10:2- Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.
