



News from the Field: Gotani



March 24, 2013 is a historical date for us as it is the day we officially moved to the "bush" of Gotani, home of the Nurmay Missions Training Center! We are happy to be "on-site" where we can work more effectively. We are living in one half of the duplex and are praying for the finances to finish the other half this year. We have also started construction on the ablution block which contains men's and women's toilets and showers and an area for washing clothes. It will be used for conferences and seminars as well as for the

students of the training center and for visiting teams. After finishing the duplex and the bathrooms, the next phase will be the student dorms.



Another historical date is June 5-7, 2013 which marked the date of the first ever conference at the Missionary Training Center, Gotani! In partnership with Multi-Church Pastor Institute, Nurmay Missions welcomed 32 pastors and church leaders from 16 different ministries to our campus for 3 days of teaching and fellowship. They were taught principles of church leadership like Time management, church finances, and church administration. Though the center is still under construction we want to be faithful to use what God has given us to bless the community and advance His Kingdom! Before the end of this year we will be holding 3 more conferences in Gotani- a women's conference, a youth conference and a pastors' conference.

PAJERO UPDATE!



May 22, 2013 was a day of salvation for us! We were travelling to pick up Nurmay missionaries who are working in Masalani when the brakes of our Pajero failed and the car slid off the dirt road and flipped! We praise God for his grace and mercy and for saving us from serious injury. As for the car... he suffered serious damage and up to this point is still not working, so we are actively pursuing other possibilities! Since we now live in "the bush" we desperately need transportation. It is very costly and difficult to get around without it!
