News from the Field: Gotani

The "road" to our house.



We have been living in the "bush" of Gotani for about 3 months now and we LOVE it! When I say bush, what I mean is this... the nearest grocery store is about an hour away, the nearest gas station, 15 minutes, we have electricity only when we turn on our little generator, water when we have it trucked in to fill our tanks. Many of our neighbors live in mud huts with grass roofs, spend their days working in the field, fetching water and cooking over an open fire. We really feel an anointing here. The one thing that all our visitors notice is how peaceful and beautiful Gotani is. We are

so blessed to live here and thank God for the way He led us to this place and for how He continues to provide what we need to bring the vision that He gave us to pass. We have been in "construction mode" since August of last year, building the duplex, digging water and septic tanks, building an outdoor latrine and our most recent project a gazebo which will be used for conferences and as a temporary classroom. As the Lord provides the funds the construction will continue with dorms, classroom, kitchen, and conference hall, but in the meantime we have a busy schedule of ministry activities for the rest of this year. In August we will be hosting a pastors' breakfast for all the pastors from the surrounding areas. We want to introduce ourselves and the ministry of Nurmay and plant the seed about the

missions training school which is scheduled to open next year. We will also be having a kids' day- it will include a Bible lesson, activities and games, and lunch for about 200-300 kids. In September we will be hosting a women's conference in Gotani. We expect 30-35 church leaders and pastors' wives. The theme, requested by the women themselves, is "The Role of the Christian woman in the Home and in the Church." In October, we will be celebrating the 3rd anniversary of the Masalani Church with a celebration and unveiling of the official church name. In November, there will be a 3-day pastors' conference with 50 pastors from 25 or more different churches and ministries. We are also very excited to be receiving Drs. Diego and Tatiana Baretto and Pastor Gessuy Freitas who will be coming in November for a week-long dental outreach. We will close the year out with a 2-day youth conference for 200-300 youth in December. We thank God for His leading and anointing in each and every plan and we thank you, our faithful friends and supporters, for your partnership with us in this exciting journey!
