Our very first **Kids' Day** in Gotani was a huge success! Thank you **South Monroe Church** for sponsoring this awesome day of ministry! Over 300 kids came out for a day of games, Bible lessons, memory verses and gifts. Our friend and fellow missionary, Lucy Mathenge came from Nairobi and did an amazing job ministering the Gospel message- every child responded to the call for salvation. Each participating church sent at least one Sunday school teacher or children's worker and they were exposed to a new way to minister to children. Many times the children

are overlooked and it is not considered important to minister to their spiritual needs. Through this program the children were blessed and the teachers were challenged to see the children as God sees them. Another first was the first annual **women's conference**. I think I can speak for everyone involved when I say that it superseded all our expectations! 32 women participated in the 3-day conference. The women really soaked up the teaching and begged for more! On the last day we had a time for questions and when lunch time came they said, "We are not hungry, we just want to hear more of the Word." Each person, including the speakers, was touched in a special way. One thing that really impacted the women was that the men cooked for them! Most of them had never been served by a man in their lives! It was an amazing testimony to them to see pastors showing the love of God through humbling themselves in service to the women who work so hard every day to serve others. The men worked very hard to make everything special for the ladies. The food was lovingly prepared and was delicious and on time every day. Congratulations guys, you did an outstanding job! On the last day the women were blessed with gifts at a special lunch that was set up like a banquet. They were speechless- never having experienced something like that before!. Nurmay missionaries, Jackson and Deborah Mbok and their family are doing an amazing work in Masalani. We are privileged to have them as a part of Nurmay. We just got the exciting news that Pauline, a regular church attender for many years, just got saved! She knew her Bible, but when we asked her if she wanted to give her life to Jesus she always said, "I am not ready, but someday I will." We thank God, "someday" finally came! Recently, Jackson contracted typhoid because the only source of water is from the contaminated Tana River. We

have been exploring options for bringing clean water to this family and the Masalani community and we are excited about the prospect of putting a hand-dug well on the church compound. This type of well, while much less expensive (about \$4000) than a borehole well, will still bring plenty of clean water to the community. A generous donor has agreed to match all gifts up to \$2000 towards this project. This means that we only need \$2000 to bring clean water to this precious family and community.
